

## PRINA GROUP: FLOOR COMPETITION 1. GEL MANICURE (STUDENT/ JUNIOR/ SENIOR GROUP)

Theme: Free-style/ Competitor's choice. Model's nails must be able to communicate competitor's choice of theme.

STUDENT GROUP (60 minutes)	The model's Left Hand must be polished with Red Crème Gel Manicure application.  Nailart shall be applied on the Ring finger of the Left Hand, with 90% coverage, with minimum FOUR colors on the nail with nailart.  The model's Right Hand must be polished with French Gel Manicure application (Pink shades & white).
JUNIOR GROUP (60 minutes)	The model's Left Hand must be polished with Red Crème Gel Manicure application.  Nailart shall be applied on the Thumb & Ring finger of the Left Hand, with 90% coverage, with minimum FOUR colors on the nail with nailart.  The model's Right Hand must be polished with French Gel Manicure application (Pink shades & white).
SENIOR GROUP (60 minutes)	The model's Left Hand must be polished with Gel Manicure application (any color).  Nailart shall be applied on the Thumb, Index finger, Middle finger & Pinky finger of the Left Hand, with 90% coverage, with minimum FOUR colors on the nail with nailart.  The model's Right Hand must be polished with French Gel Manicure application (Pink shades & white).

  - 1. Competitors will have to complete the Gel Manicure Application on TWO hands within 60 minutes.
  - There is no restriction on the colors used for the application on the Left hand.
  - 3. The theme for the nailart is free-style. All the nailart must be of the same theme. The overall look should easily communicate the theme chosen.
  - 4. The model's natural nails must NOT be ROUND shape before the competition commences. Product may NOT be applied until the competition has commenced.
  - 5. The models must have natural nails only. No nail extension is permitted.
  - 6. Products must be in the original manufacturer's pots or bottles and must be clearly labelled.
  - 7. Proper table setup, sanitizing and gel manicure procedure must be adhered to.
  - 8. Only water can be used for cleaning. Oil, soap and moisturizer cream are NOT permitted.
  - 9. Gel competitors must bring their own UV/LED Gel lamp.

Nail Shape - The final shape of the nails is to be ROUND and look consistent and uniform. The top of the free-edge must not be uneven and the free-edge is straight from the nail plate.

**Length -** The final length of the nails is to have a minimum 3-5mm free-edge.

**Product Application -** Application at cuticle is clean. Product is evenly applied. No product on cuticle/skin or underside of the nail. No streaks, pits & bubbles.

Use of Colors - Colors used should be in line with the theme each competitor wants to portray.

Level of Difficulty - The nailart needs to display different nailart techniques that fit the theme of your choice.

Cuticle Area - No cuts or irritation around skin. No product ledge or missing product.

**Finishing -** There should not be any scratches in the paint or product application. The cuticle is clean and the entire nail is to have a final high gloss finish of Top Gel/ Sealer.

Underside - No visible dust, debris, water, glue, oil or polish. No excess product.

Judging Criteria: Nail Shape, Product Application, Overall Work, Cuticle Area, Smile Line, Finishing, High Shine Finish, Table Presentation, Creativity, Clarity of Design, Level of Difficulty, Overall Workmanship, Use of Color, Theme Relevance, Complexity

### 2. ACRYLIC EXTENSIONS (STUDENT/ JUNIOR/ SENIOR GROUP)

Theme: Free-style/ Competitor's choice. Model's nails must be able to communicate competitor's choice of theme.

STUDENT GROUP (90 minutes)	The model's ONE Hand must be completed with CLEAR Nail Tip Extensions, with glitter gradient at the free-edge.	THE RESIDENCE OF THE PARTY OF T
JUNIOR GROUP (90 minutes)	The model's ONE Hand must be completed with CLEAR Nail Tip Extensions, with glitter gradient of minimum TWO colors on the whole nail or up to the lunula area.	
SENIOR GROUP (90 minutes)	The model's ONE Hand must be completed with Sculpture Extensions, with glitter gradient of minimum TWO colors on the full nail or up to the lunula area Middle finger & pinky finger needs to have embossed nailart of at least 50% coverage, with minimum FOUR colors on each nailart.

- 1. Competitors will have to complete the Acrylic Extension on ONE hand (five fingers) in 90 minutes.
- 2. In the event where competition work is only to be executed on one hand, the other hand needs to be covered with red polish color (TWO layers) before the start of the competition.
- 3. Colors used are up to the competitor's creativity.
- 4. The theme for the nailart is free-style. All the nailart must be of the same theme. The overall look should easily communicate the theme chosen.
- 5. The model's natural nails may be prepared for product application before the competition commences. Product may NOT be applied until the competition has commenced.
- 6. Nail Sculpture forms must be flat and uncut before the start of the competition.
- 7. Size of nail tips can be chosen before the start of the competition. No amendments can be made until the start of the competition.
- 8. Products must be in the original manufacturer's pots or bottles and must be clearly labelled.
- 9. Only water can be used for cleaning. Oil, soap and moisturizer cream are NOT permitted.
- 10. Drills are allowed, but competitor must supply their own drill and have ample electrical cords and adaptors.
- 11. Shape of the final nail extension is SQUARE.

**C-Curve -** The c-curves should have at the very minimum 40-50% of a circle. They must be symmetrical and measures evenly on each side. There should not be any dents or imperfections.

**Free-Edge Thickness -** The nails must be consistently thin throughout the entire nails free-edge and be uniformly thin on each nail. The free-edge should be no thicker than a credit card.

Sidewalls or Groove-Walls The free-edge must extend straight out from the lateral folds. The nail should not flare out or taper in. The nail must be uniform on each side. There cannot be any notches or ridges on sidewalls.

**Length -** The nail is measured from the Cuticle to centre of the smile-line to match the length of the top of the free-edge to the tips of the smile-line.

**Nail Shape -** The shape of the nail extensions to be SQUARE and must look consistent and uniform. The top of the free-edge must not be uneven. The free-edge should not look as if the finger was crooked and that the nail is off in a tilted direction.

**High Shine Finish** The finger with nailart should be finished with top coat/ gel top coat. Acrylic Extension without the nailart should be buffed to high shine.

**Use of Colors -** Colors used should be in line with the theme each competitor wants to portray.

Level of Difficulty - The nailart needs to display different nailart techniques that fit the theme of the nails.

Cuticle Area - No cuts or irritation around skin. No product ledge or missing product.

**Underside -** There should be no visible dust, debris, water, glue, oil or polish on the back of the nail. The product application must appear smooth behind the nail with no excess product.

Judging Criteria: Nail Shape, Product Application, Overall work, Cuticle Area, Finishing, High Shine Finish, Table Presentation, Creativity, Clarity of Design, Level of Difficulty, Overall Workmanship, Use of Color, Theme Relevance, Complexity

Theme: Free-style/ Competitor's choice. Model's nails must be able to communicate competitor's choice of theme.

- Competitors will have to complete the Gel Extension on ONE hand (five fingers) in 90 minutes.
- 2. In the event where work is to be executed only on one hand, the other hand needs to be covered with red polish color (TWO layers) before the start of the competition.
- 3. Colors used are up to the competitor's creativity.
- 4. The theme for the nailart is free-style. All the nailart must be of the same theme. The overall look should easily communicate the theme chosen.
- 5. The model's natural nails may be prepared for product application before the competition commences. Product may NOT be applied until the competition has commenced.
- 6. Nail Sculpture forms must be flat and uncut before the start of the competition.
- 7. Size of nail tips can be chosen before the start of the competition. No amendments can be made until the start of the competition.
- 8. Products must be in the original manufacturer's pots or bottles and must be clearly labelled.
- 10. Only water can be used for cleaning. Oil, soap and moisturizer cream are NOT permitted.
- 12. Shape of the final nail extension is SQUARE.

**C-Curve -** The c-curves should have at the very minimum 40-50% of a circle. They must be symmetrical and measures evenly on each side. There should not be any dents or imperfections.

**Free-Edge Thickness** The nails must be consistently thin throughout the entire nails free-edge and be uniformly thin on each nail. The free-edge should be no thicker than a credit card.

**Sidewalls or Groove-Walls -** The free-edge must extend straight out from the lateral folds. The nail should not flare out or taper in. The nail must be uniform on each side. There cannot be any notches or ridges on sidewalls.

**Length -** The nail is measured from the Cuticle to centre of the smile-line to match the length of the top of the free-edge to the tips of the smile-line.

**Nail Shape -** The shape of the nail extensions to be SQUARE and must look consistent and uniform. The top of the Free-edge must not be uneven. The free-edge should not look as if the finger was crooked and that the nail is off in a tilted direction.

High Shine Finish - All nails should be finished with Top Gel/sealer.

**Use of Colors -** Colors used should be in line with the theme each competitor wants to portray.

**Level of Difficulty -** The nailart needs to display different nailart techniques that fit the theme of the nails.

Cuticle Area - No cuts or irritation around skin. No product ledge or missing product.

**Underside -** There should be no visible dust, debris, water, glue, oil or polish on the back of the nail. The product application must appear smooth behind the nail with no excess product.

Judging Criteria: Nail Shape, Product Application, Overall work, Cuticle Area, Finishing, High Shine Finish, Table Presentation, Creativity, Clarity of design, Level of Difficulty, Overall Workmanship, Use of Color, Theme Relevance, Complexity, Gel Polish Application



## PRINA GROUP: FLOOR COMPETITION 4. MIXED MEDIA TOTAL LOOK (TEAM WORK)

Theme: Free-style/ Competitor's choice. Model's nails must be able to communicate competitor's choice of theme.

# OPEN TO ALL PRINA STUDENTS

(45 minutes)

#### **Before the competition:**

According to the theme chose, the team will need to prepare:

- Hair & makeup
- Costume/ attire
- Empty nail tips for displaying the nailart on the model's nail
- Pre-completed nailart elements (by materials normally used for nailart/ nail extensions etc)
   \*Model's nails must be prepped before the competition.

#### At the competition:

- 1. Attach empty nail tips onto model's bare nails
- 2. Apply color/ acrylic color powder/ gel as base for nailart
- Attached pre-completed nailart elements onto nail tips with glue or acrylic powder etc. Apply top coat on overall nail tips.
- 4. Nail model to pose with nailart and full hair & makeup and attire in the best light to show the theme of the team.
- 1. The Mixed Media competition should be prepared by the competitor prior to the competition and to be assembled in 45 minutes for judging.
- 2. Each team should consist of 2-3 competitors & 1 model.
- 3. There must be a Team name and a reason for teaming (e.g. Sisters, BFF, classmates, salon etc).
- 4. The theme for the nailart is free-style. All the nailart must be of the same theme for each hand. The theme of the nail must be written on the model's sticker. The overall look should easily communicate the theme chosen.
- 5. The model's natural nails may be prepared for product application before the competition commences. The model's nails must be bare before the start of the competition.
- 6. Only the model and competitors are allowed on the competition floor for judging.
- 7. Every competitor must be ready to verbally explain how something was created, if asked by the judges.
- 8. Keep in mind the costume, hair and makeup is a large part of this competition. The judging is based on the overall look.
- 9. The dressing needs to match the theme of the nails.
- 10. Competitors must NOT use any copyright art, design or logos (e.g. Sanrio, Disney...).

Costume - Overall model's image is assessed. Hair & makeup are also taken into consideration.

Creativity - A creative use of design and art materials according to the theme chosen.

Theme Relevance - The theme is free-style. The overall look should match the theme chosen.

Level of Difficulty - Complexity of the design and art elements.

Finish - Completeness of work. Clarity and quality of the design.

Originality - Creative and unusual presentation of theme.

Judging Criteria: Costume, Overall Look, Composition, Creativity, Theme Relevance, Use of Color, Overall Workmanship, Clarity of Design, Finish, Originality, General impression, Nailart Complexity, Drawing Techniques, Continuity of Theme

- Only standard nailart material can be used. There is no restriction on the theme, colors used or techniques used. All embellishments have to be handmade.
- 6. At least 3 different kinds of nailart techniques must be used.
- 7. 3D and embossed nailart must not extend further than 0.6cm from the original nail surface in any direction.
- 8. The Nailart Submission form can be collected at PinkRoom@IP upon competition registration & payment. For Online Registration, the form will be provided via email.
- 9. Nail tips are to be mounted securely on to a mounting board of maximum  $20cm \times 15cm$  with a frame. The frame must have a clear top.
- 10. Mounting board must be in one color, flat with no textured surfaces and no less than 0.25mm thick.
- 11. Competitor's name, Techniques & material used and Description of the nailart work must be written on the Submission Form and attached to the frame for submission.
- 12. Nailart work for the Nail Tips Submission categories can be collected at PinkRoom@IP after 3 months from the competition.
- 13. Nailart will be displayed in our Gallery on the day of the event. The Gallery will be opened to all our international guests, reporters (local & international), students, friends & family.

- 9. Nail tips are to be mounted securely on to a mounting board of maximum 20cm x 15cm with a frame. The frame must have a clear top.
- 10. Mounting board must be in one color, flat with no textured surfaces and no less than 0.25mm thick.
- 11. Competitor's name, Techniques & material used and Description of the nailart work must be written on the Submission Form and attached to the frame for submission.
- 12. Nailart will be displayed in our Gallery on the day of the event. The Gallery will be opened to all our international guests, reporters (local & international), students, friends & family.

- 3. The theme for the nailart is free-style. All the nailart must be of the same theme for each set. The overall look should easily communicate the theme chosen.
- 4. The length of the tip must be no longer than 5cm in length, and 2cm in width.
- 5. Bulk of the design should be completed using rhinestones, metal decos, metal studs, glitter flakes, and any nailart deco accessories that are commonly used for nailart. There is no restriction on the theme, material, colors or techniques used.
- 6. The deco must not extend further than 0.6cm from the original nail surface in any direction.

- 8. Nail tips are to be mounted securely on to a mounting board of maximum  $20 \, \text{cm} \times 15 \, \text{cm}$  with a frame. The frame must have a clear top.
- 9. Mounting board must be in one color, flat with no textured surfaces and no less than 0.25mm thick.
- 10. Competitor's name, Techniques & material used and Description of the nailart work must be written on the Submission Form and attached to the frame for submission.





# OPEN TO ALL PRINA STUDENTS

Nails should not go higher than 70-80% of the whole picture. Competitors do not need to add in the magazine header logo.

Refer to the illustration for sample of how the photo should look.

Nails should be photographed in the position that best portrays the nailart work for judging & voting by the public.

The model's hand must be:

- 1. Holding an object symbolising Singapore
- 2. Resting on an object symbolising Singapore
- 3. Taken with a landscape of Singapore at the background





Leave about 20-30% space above the hand for placement of magazine header logo.

- 1. Each photograph needs to feature the nailart with a Magazine Cover photo Layout.
- Leave at least 20-30% background space on the top of the poster for the header logo. The header logo will be added by the organiser after submission.
- 3. The theme for the nailart is "SG50". All the nailart must be of the same theme for each set. The overall look should easily communicate the theme chosen. Refer to www.the-pinkroom.com/prcup/sg50 to find out about SG50.
- 4. Each photograph must include one or two human hands with all nails ready for judging.
- 5. Competitors may include background images, editing, effects etc. There is no limitation to your creativity.
- 6. Nails should be shown clearly in the picture. Picture of the nails that are blurry, blocked by watermark/ effects etc will affect the judges' score.
- 7. All nailart must be handmade. Embossed nailart must not extend further than 0.6cm from the original nail surface in any direction.
- 8. At least 3 different kinds of nailart techniques must be used.
- 9. Nailart can be done on natural nails, or nail extensions. There is no restriction on the model's nails and hand.
- 10. Photos submitted should not have any watermark to ensure fair judging.
- 11. Photos will be posted on the PRINA Facebook page for public online voting for PRINA Nail Award.
- 12. Selected photos will be printed for display in our Photo Gallery on the day of the event. The Gallery will be opened to all our international guests, reporters (local & international), students, friends & family.
- 13. Submission deadline can be found on <a href="https://www.the-pinkroom.com/prcup">www.the-pinkroom.com/prcup</a>.
- 14. Digital photo must be submitted in PNG, JPEG or PDF format, at least A4, 300dpi, portrait layout. Physical printout will not be accepted as this is an Online Photo Competition.
- 15. Quality of the photo has to be suitable for printing of up to A4 size.
